
Why is the Colorado Poison Center important?

An estimated **§19.0 million** in healthcare costs were saved in Colorado by utilizing the Colorado Poison Center to treat poisoning cases at the site of exposure rather than in an emergency department or doctor's office.

- Poisoning is the second leading cause of unintentional death due to injury in the United States.
- For every dollar spent on poison center services, <u>\$13.39</u> is . saved in medical expenses.
- The Colorado Poison Center staff provides emergency poison treatment information that may prevent an unnecessary hospital visit.

2013 Facts...

- The Colorado Poison Center managed 53,972 cases through its 24-hour hotline.
- 50% of exposed cases involved children under age 5.
- 71% of poison exposure calls that came from the public were treated on site where the poisoning occurred saving the time and costs of an emergency department visit.
- 29% of exposures were referred into a doctor or other healthcare facility for treatment.






