## Saving Lives with Answers...


Why is the Hawaii Poison Center important?

An estimated **\$ 3.0 million** in healthcare costs were saved in Hawaii by utilizing the Hawaii Poison Center to treat poisoning cases at the site of exposure rather than in an emergency department or doctor's office.

- Poisoning is the second leading cause of unintentional death due to injury in the United States.
- For every dollar spent on poison center services, \$11 is saved in medical expenses.
- The Hawaii Poison Center's staff provides emergency poison treatment information that may prevent an unnecessary hospital visit.

## 2012 Facts...


- The Hawaii Poison Center managed
  11,712 cases through its 24-hour hotline.
  In addition there were 3,276 Hawaii
  HELP (VOG) calls.
- 47% of exposed cases involved children under age 5.
- 67% of poison exposure calls that came from the public were treated on site where the poisoning occurred saving the time and costs of an emergency department visit.
- **33%** of exposures were referred into a doctor or other healthcare facility for treatment.
