### Saving Lives with Answers...


Why is the Hawaii Poison Center important?

An estimated <u>\$ 2.7 million</u> in healthcare costs were saved in Hawaii by utilizing the Hawaii Poison Center to treat poisoning cases at the site of exposure rather than in an emergency department or doctor's office.

- Poisoning is the second leading cause of unintentional death due to injury in the United States.
- For every dollar spent on poison center services, **\$13.39** is saved in medical expenses.
- The Hawaii Poison Center's staff provides emergency poison treatment information that may prevent an unnecessary hospital visit.

#### 2014 Facts...


- The Hawaii Poison Center managed **9,584** cases through its 24-hour hotline.
- 43% of exposed cases involved children under age 5.
- 64% of poison exposure calls that came from the public were treated on site where the poisoning occurred saving the time and costs of an emergency department visit.
- **36%** of exposures were referred into a doctor or other healthcare facility for treatment.






