
Why is the Nevada Poison Center important?

An estimated **\$ 7.4 million** in healthcare costs were saved in Nevada by utilizing the Nevada Poison Center to treat poisoning cases at the site of exposure rather than in an emergency department or doctor's office.

- Poisoning is the second leading cause of unintentional death due to injury in the United States.
- For every dollar spent on poison center services, \$11 is saved in medical expenses.
- The Nevada Poison Center staff provides emergency poison treatment information that may prevent an unnecessary hospital visit.

2012 Facts...


- The Nevada Poison Center managed 34,334 cases through its 24 hour hotline.
- 46% of these exposure cases involved children under age 5.
- 68% of poison exposure cases that came from the public were treated on site where the poisoning occurred saving the time and costs of an emergency department visit.
- 32% of exposures were referred into a doctor or other healthcare facility for treatment.







